

Number of participants: 5 participants (17-23) + 1 leader (no age limit) → total of 30 participants





Project details:

The theme of the project is entrepreneurship, and within the project youngsters will have the opportunity to acquire practical knowledge about the necessary steps for creating a business. They will work on their own business idea that they will plan in detail, they will present them, they will become aware of their own abilities, they will develop their entrepreneurial skills and attitudes through a range of non-formal activities..

The youth exchange will have activities like: interactive presentations, creative workshops, team building games, simulation games, promotion materials creation, study visit, evaluation sessions, intercultural evenings etc.

Objectives of the youth exchange:

- Acquiring basic knowledge of the steps required to create a business by 30 young people
- Developing transversal skills and entrepreneurial skills among the 30 young people
- Improving the self-awareness and personal development of young people, necessary for building an entrepreneurial spirit
- Learning about the possibilities offered by the Erasmus + program by 30 young people

Accommodation:

The location of the project will be Oradea, at a nice place called Posticum. The location of the project has a conference room, dining room, a terrace and garden.

The participants will have to bring with them all of their original tickets, receipts and boarding passes and copies of their travel documents (passports, identity cards) as we will collect all of them at the end of the youth exchange. In addition, participants are required to send us by post all of their original return tickets, receipts and boarding passes within 1 week of their departure from the youth exchange otherwise, we will not be able to refund them. Please keep in mind, that without the original tickets, receipts and boarding passes, we cannot reimburse your money!

IMPORTANT! In case a group wants to arrange some extra travelling before or after the project, please remember that the travel must be organized within maximum 2 days before and 2 days after the end of the project, according to the Erasmus+ Program Guide!

The Romanian currency is RON, and 1 Euro is approximately 4,65 RON.

Information about Romania:

Romania is one of the largest countries of Europe (the size of the United Kingdom or roughly half of France), with a population of approx. 22 million inhabitants. Along with the Romanians, Hungarians, Germans, Serbs, Turks and other minorities also live in the country.

Capital: Bucharest (Bucuresti)

Form of State: Semi-parliamentary Republic with two legislative bodies: Senate (Senat) and Chamber of Representatives (Camera Deputatilor)

Oradea:

Located just 8 miles from the Hungarian border, the elegant city of Oradea is a great starting point for exploring Romania. Oradea is remarkable for its particularly rich collection of Art Nouveau architecture.

Oradea University, one of the largest in Eastern Europe, is an excellent educational center in literature, as well as in medicine and sciences.
